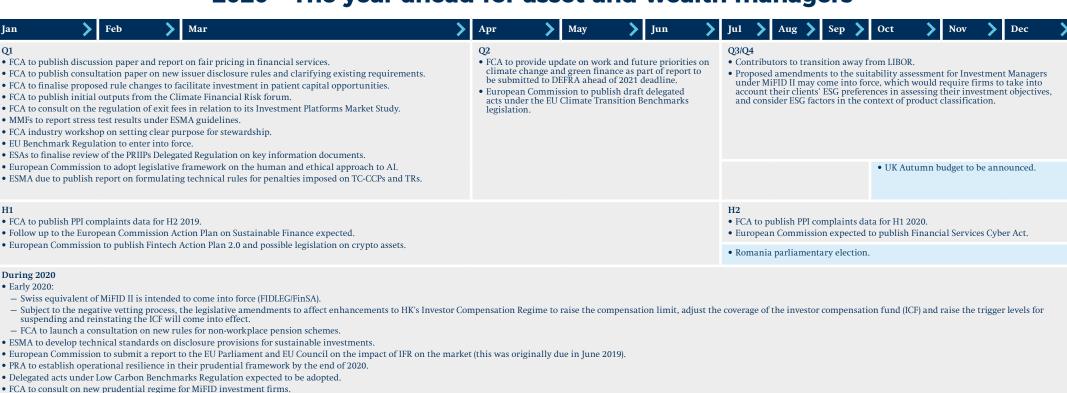

- Asset managers to consider future transparency and disclosure obligations relating to sustainability under the new Disclosure Regulations (to apply in 2021).
